Generally accepted professional inspection standards and methods shall be used. **This home inspection is being performed in accordance with the standards of practice of the North Carolina Home Inspector Licensing Board and a copy of these guidelines are available from said Board.** Absolutely no warranties or guarantees are given or implied for any latent, concealed or omitted defects. Additionally, the Client agrees that any deficiencies (and the components and systems associated with the deficiencies) noted in the report be inspected, evaluated, and repaired as necessary by licensed contractors or professionals prior to the close of escrow. KO Home Inspections LLC is not liable for any defects, deficiencies, or omissions which cannot be reasonably discovered during the limited visual inspection. As part of your general home inspection the KO Home Inspections LLC will inspect and report on the following areas unless that area has been specifically excluded from our services:

- 1. <u>STRUCTURAL COMPONENTS</u> including foundation, flooring, floors, walls, columns, ceilings and roofs.
- 2. <u>EXTERIOR OF STRUCTURE</u> including wall cladding, entryway doors, decks, steps, eaves, driveways and a representative number of windows.
- 3. ROOFING including roof coverings, roof drainage systems, flashing, skylights, and chimneys.
- 4. <u>PLUMBING</u> including interior water supply & distribution systems, interior drain waste & vent system, fuel storage, distribution system, and sump pumps. To properly inspect the plumbing and gas systems, they must be turned on at the time of inspection.
- 5. <u>ELECTRICAL</u>- including service entrance conductors, service equipment, main distribution panels, voltage ratings, a representative number of installed ceiling fans, lighting fixtures, switches and receptacles, ground fault circuit interrupters and smoke detectors.
- 6. <u>HEATING SYSTEM</u> including permanently installed heating systems and their controls, chimneys, heat distribution ducts, fans, and pumps, and their automatic safety controls. Furnaces must be "on" or capable of being turned on by using normal operating controls. Pilot lights must be "lit" in order to inspect these components or systems. We do not operate heating systems in temperatures that may cause damage to the unit (Heat Pump over 65 degrees)
- 7. <u>CENTRAL AIR</u> including normal operating control of the central air conditioning system and the distribution system. To prevent damage to the system we do no operate AC systems when the temperature is below 65°.
- 8. INTERIOR including walls, ceilings, floors, steps, a representative number of cabinets and doors and windows.
- 9. <u>INSULATION AND VENTILATION</u> including insulation, vapor barriers, ventilation of attic and foundation, kitchen, bathrooms and laundry venting systems, and the operation of any readily accessible attic ventilation fan, when temperature permits.
- 10. BUILT-IN KITCHEN APPLIANCES including the observation and operation of the dishwasher, range, trash
